

“Bergh Apton Charities is the working name of the Thursby and Poors Allotment Trust. The Trust received Charity Commission registration approval in 1966.

The charity holds land and financial investments, which primarily provides income along with some growth. The income received is expected to be distributed in accordance with the charities aim of providing relief to residents of Bergh Apton parish.

Last year Trustees approved a distribution of £5000, the largest on record. 21 individuals each received £200, 2 individuals each received £50, and £700 was donated to Alington & Bergh Apton school, to benefit children from Bergh Apton parish.

The distribution made last year, again exceeded the income received in the year, with Trustees again, making the decision to reduce some surplus cash held by the trust, in order to provider a greater level of help.”
